Storm Season Checklist

Summer is here - the storms prove it!!!

Are you ready for this season... follow our checklist for your window maintenance - to keep your family safe this season

- ✓ Ensure that the tracks of your windows and doors are clean and cleared of all debris and dirt.
- ✓ Make sure that the seals or vinyl on your windows and doors is in place
- ✓ If you have weather strips make sure they are working as designed
- ✓ Windows and doors have a weather pile inserted as part of their manufacture - this can also be referred to as mohair. It is designed to stop the wind and whistle in your windows. Make sure yours is still there and has not be worn away *
- ✓ Store loose furniture and knickknacks away from windows.
- ✓ Ensure that there is an emergency kit handy and it is updated.
- ✓ Establish a safe area/muster area somewhere in the home. It would be best if the chosen location does not have windows or glass doors.
- ✓ Have emergency food supplies for each member of the household enough for at least two to three days. These foods should not require cooking so include canned and dry foods.
- ✓ Ensure that there are extra batteries, flashlights, candles, water, toiletries, matches, lighter, propane, et cetera as part of your emergency kit
- ✓ Secure all outdoor fixtures and furniture that could potentially become airborne in a storm.
- ✓ If there is a generator at your disposal, ensure that there is more than enough fuel and it is in good working order.
- ✓ Trim all overhanging branches so that they do not pose a danger to the roof, windows, et cetera. Contact the power company to remove branches near power lines.
- ✓ Mend any windows or doors that are not currently in good repair.
